## FVPG JURIED SHOW Guidelines

## **CLAY 2011**

Juried by Meira Mathison on April 5th At the Maple Ridge Genstar Theatre next to the Gallery

This show is open to all guild members in good standing. The fee to enter is \$15. per person. Members <u>must enter at least 2 items</u> to make the jurying process relevant, but may enter up to 10 entries, 2 of which may be sets, and should be made within the last year and not previously shown. From these the juror will select the show pieces, making sure to include at least one per entrant. We will also feature our mug wall, and members can bring 10 items for this over and above the show pieces. There is no insurance for breakage while on the premises. Individuals are advised to take out insurance on their own items if desired. Sale of work will be handled by the Gallery with 30% commission.

The jurying will take place at Maple Ridge Art Gallery on April 5<sup>th</sup>. Please drop off your pots between 10:00am and 12:00noon with your <u>Entry Form</u>, an <u>Artist Statement</u>, and your <u>cheque for \$15</u>. made out to FVPGA. For those working, please make arrangements with a friend. The Artist Statement is a nice feature that we would like to put in a binder for the show. Potential buyers like to know something about the artist.

Juror's comments will take place that same evening between 7 and 10pm. All pieces selected for the show will be left on site. All pieces not selected for the show must be taken home following the juror's comments.

The show will be set up on April 6th, but the Opening Reception and Award presentation will be April 9<sup>th</sup> Sat. from 2-4pm. The Gallery will supply tea and coffee, and our Guild members will supply food items for everyone's enjoyment.

The Show ends Sat. May 7<sup>th</sup> at 4pm and members can pick up their work between 2 and 3:30, or on Mon. May 9<sup>th</sup> at 10am. If you are unable to be there, please make arrangements for someone else to pick up your work. Storage at the Gallery is very limited.
